# Maplewood's New Requirements for Condiment Packets & Plastic Utensils

You know those pouches that contain single-use quantities of foods such as ketchup, mustard, sugar or soy sauce that many food establishments throw into your own to go bag. How about the plastic forks, spoons and stirrers that are tossed into your bag? Well beginning in 2021, these items can only be provided by a food establishment at



the request of a customer or at a self-service utensil and condiment station. If you need sugar for your coffee, a fork for your salad, or ketchup for your frenchfries, you'll have to ask for it or take some from a condiment station in the store.



And what about plastic straws or stirrers? You must request a disposable plastic straw or stirrer when buying takeout or at a diner or restaurant when they serve a drink like water, soft drinks or iced tea to you at your table. Also, plastic straws and stirrers will not be available at self-service stations.
